



AUSTRALIAN CUSTOMS DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2010/23

Greyback cartonboard

From The Republic Korea

Finding in relation to a review of anti-dumping measures

Customs Act 1901 – Part XVB

The Australian Customs and Border Protection Service (Customs and Border Protection) has completed its review of the anti-dumping measures applying to exports of greyback cartonboard exported to Australia from the Republic of Korea (Korea). The review commenced on 3 December 2009.

The goods covered by the review are coated greyback cartonboard, grey on one side and coated white on the other side (greyback cartonboard are cellulose fibre based paperboards containing recycled fibre; thicknesses range from 320 to 720 microns, which corresponds to a weight range of 250 to 550 grams per square metre).

The goods are classified under tariff subheading 4810.13.90 statistical code 56, 4810.19.90 statistical code 57, 4810.29.90 statistical code 64 and 80 and 4810.99.00 statistical code 85 in Schedule 3 of the *Customs Tariff Act 1995*. The rate of duty for greyback cartonboard from Korea is five percent.

The Attorney-General (Minister) has considered Trade Measures Report 155 (the Report) and has accepted the recommendations and reasons for the recommendations, including all material findings of fact or law set out in the Report.

Under s. 269ZDB(1) of the *Customs Act 1901*, the Minister declared, for the purposes of the *Customs Act 1901* and the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975* to the extent that anti-dumping measures concerning the goods involved the publication of a dumping duty notice that, with effect from the date of publication of the s.269ZDB(1) notice, the dumping duty notice relevant to the measures applicable to greyback cartonboard exported from Korea is to be taken to have effect, as if different variable factors had been fixed, relevant to the determination of duty.

The Minister has also declared pursuant to s. 269ZDB(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* that, if before the date specified in that notice the terms of the undertaking by Daehan Pulp Co Ltd concerning greyback cartonboard, exported to Australia from Korea, are altered in an acceptable manner, the undertaking shall be varied.

Notice of the Minister's decision was published in the Gazette and *The Australian* newspaper on 23 June 2010. The revised measures will apply to those goods exported from Korea and entered for home consumption from the date of publication of the Minister's decision on 23 June 2010.

To preserve confidentiality, details of the revised variable factors will not be published. Bona fide importers of the goods can obtain details of the new rates from the Regional Dumping Liaison Officer in their respective capital city.
