AUSTRALIAN CUSTOMS DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2010/05

Continuation inquiry into anti-dumping measures applying to greyback cartonboard exported from the Republic of Korea

Extension of time to issue the statements of essential facts

CUSTOMS ACT 1901 - PART XVB

On 4 November 2009, the Australian Customs and Border Protection Service (Customs and Border Protection) published a notice announcing the initiation of a continuation inquiry into anti-dumping measures applying to exports of greyback cartonboard from the Republic of Korea (Korea) to Australia.

A full description of the goods is available in Australian Customs Dumping Notice (ACDN) No. 2009/36. This ACDN is available on the internet at www.customs.gov.au

The initiation notice and ACDN 2009/36 advised that the statement of essential facts (SEF) for the continuation inquiry would be placed on the public record by 22 February 2010. The SEF sets out the facts on which Customs and Border Protection proposes to base its recommendations to the Minister for Home Affairs (the Minister).

Customs and Border Protection considered the prescribed 110 days to place the SEF on the public record for the continuation inquiry was insufficient and it requested an extension of the deadline for the publication of the SEF.

The Minister has, under s. 269ZHI of the *Customs Act 1901*, extended the deadline for the publication of the SEF. The SEF will now be placed on the public record no later than 23 March 2010.

Interested parties are invited to make submissions to Customs and Border Protection in response to the SEF within 20 days of the SEF being placed on the public record. A recommendation to the Minister will be made in a report due on or before 7 May 2010.
