AUSTRALIAN CUSTOMS DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2009/48

Polyvinyl chloride homopolymer resin

Exported from the Republic of Korea

Extension of time to issue the statement of essential facts

CUSTOMS ACT 1901 - PART XVB

On 28 May 2009, the Australian Customs and Border Protection Service (Customs and Border Protection) published a notice announcing the initiation of an inquiry into whether the continuation of anti-dumping measures in respect of Polyvinyl chloride homopolymer resin (PVC) exported from the Republic of Korea (Korea) is justified.

Further details of the continuation inquiry are available in Australian Customs Dumping Notice (ACDN) No. 2008/26. This ACDN is available on the internet at www.customs.gov.au

The initiation notice advised that the statement of essential facts (SEF) for the investigation would be placed on the public record by 14 December 2009. The SEF sets out the facts on which Customs and Border Protection proposes to base its recommendations to the Minister for Home Affairs (the Minister).

In order to properly deal with all the issues in this case, Customs and Border Protection requested an extension of the deadline for the publication of the SEF.

The Minister has, under s. 269ZHI of the *Customs Act 1901*, extended the deadline for the publication of the SEF. The SEF will now be placed on the public record no later than 11 January 2010. Customs and Border Protection will make every effort to publish the SEF at an earlier date. Interested parties are invited to make submissions to Customs and Border Protection in response to the SEF within 20 days of the SEF being placed on the public record. A recommendation to the Minister will be made in a report due on or before 25 February 2010.
