#### INTERIM DUMPING DUTY

Interim dumping duty has been determined for all exports of cast articles of iron and steel used to line grinding mills (excluding filler rings) from Canada as follows:

Exporter: All exporters

Interim dumping duty initially imposed on 17 September 2003.

Goods subject to interim dumping duty must be entered using the relevant DSN.

#### NOTES:

\* The Ascertained Export Price is based on average payment terms of all sales during the investigation period, including consignment sales. There should be no adjustment for credit terms. -The Canadian exporter currently describes its steel mill liners under the name Norsteel and its iron mill liners under the name Norchrome.

#### DIRECTION FOR COLLECTION OF INTERIM DUMPING DUTY

The amount of interim dumping duty payable shall be the sum of (a) and (b) below:

(a) The amount equal to the interim dumping duty shown in column 3 (if any) of the table;

Plus

(b) The amount, if any, by which the dumping export price (DXP) is less than the ascertained export price shown in column 4 of the table.
