



## **AUSTRALIAN CUSTOMS DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2009/34**

### **Certain aluminium extrusions Exported from the People's Republic of China Extension of time to issue the statement of essential facts**

#### **CUSTOMS ACT 1901 - PART XVB**

On 24 June 2009, the Australian Customs and Border Protection Service (Customs and Border Protection) published a notice announcing the initiation of an investigation into the alleged dumping and subsidisation of certain aluminium extrusions (aluminium extrusions) exported from the People's Republic of China (China) to Australia.

A full description of the goods is available in Australian Customs Dumping Notice (ACDN) No. 2009/20. This ACDN is available on the internet at [www.customs.gov.au](http://www.customs.gov.au)

The initiation notice advised that the statement of essential facts (SEF) for the investigation would be placed on the public record by 12 October 2009. The SEF sets out the facts on which Customs and Border Protection proposes to base its recommendations to the Minister for Home Affairs (the Minister).

Due to the complexity of the issues surrounding the investigation, as well as extensions of time allowed for various interested parties to supply information, Customs and Border Protection requested an extension of the deadline for the publication of the SEF.

The Minister has, under s. 269ZHI of the *Customs Act 1901*, extended the deadline for the publication of the SEF. The SEF will now be placed on the public record no later than 1 March 2010. Customs and Border Protection will make every effort to publish the SEF at an earlier date. Interested parties are invited to make submissions to Customs and Border Protection in response to the SEF within 20 days of the SEF being placed on the public record. A recommendation to the Minister will now be made in a report due on or before 15 April 2010.
