



AUSTRALIAN CUSTOMS DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2003/31

CUSTOMS ACT 1901 - PART XV B

NOTICE PURSUANT TO SUB-SECTION 269ZZM(4)

Affirmation of imposition of anti-dumping measures on hot rolled structural steel sections exported to Australia from the Republic of Korea and Thailand

The Australian Customs Service has completed its re-investigation of certain findings in respect of hot rolled structural steel sections exported to Australia from the Republic of Korea and Thailand.

Customs recommended to the Minister for Justice and Customs that he affirm the decision to publish dumping duty notices under s.269TG(1) and (2) of the *Customs Act 1901*. The Minister has accepted the recommendations and affirmed the decision.

Customs reinvestigation report sets out reasons for this decision, including material findings of fact or law on which the decision is based.
