## **AUSTRALIAN CUSTOMS DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2003/48**

### **CUSTOMS ACT 1901 – PART XVB**

### **TERMINATION OF AN INVESTIGATION**

### **UNCOATED WHITE CUT REAM A4 PAPER IN THE NOMINAL RANGE OF 70 – 89 G/M<sup>2</sup> EXPORTED FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA**

The Chief Executive Officer has terminated the investigation into alleged dumping of uncoated white cut ream A4 paper in the nominal range of 70 – 89 g/m<sup>2</sup> (A4 copy paper) exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China (China).

Customs initiated an investigation on 11 August 2003 following an application by Australian Paper Pty Ltd.

As a result of investigations covering the period from 1 July 2002 to 30 June 2003, Customs found that exports of A4 copy paper from China by UPM-Kymmene (Changshu) Paper Co. Ltd. and Anhui Light Industrial Import & Export Co. Ltd. were at negligible dumping margins. Under the circumstances, s.269TDA(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* requires the investigation to be terminated.

Notice of this decision will be published in *The Australian* on 27 November 2003.
