



AUSTRALIAN CUSTOMS DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2006/60

Tariff Classification changes to goods subject to anti-dumping measures and securities

Customs Tariff Amendment (2007 Harmonized System Changes) Act 2006

In Australian Customs Notice 2006/57 Customs advised that amendments to the Tariff Working Pages had been finalised. This followed changes that were contained in the *Customs Tariff Amendment (2007 Harmonized System Changes) Act 2006*, which received Royal Assent on 4 November 2006.

As a result of those changes the tariff classifications and statistical codes of certain commodities currently subject to securities, interim dumping duty and dumping duty will be affected. Commodities affected by the change are:

The changes are to take effect from 1 January 2007. Amended Dumping Commodity register pages will be published as soon as possible.

Importers should be aware that while the tariff classifications and statistical codes have changed the commodities listed still remain subject to securities, interim dumping duty and dumping duty, as the case may be. Dumping duty rate records in ICS will be amended with effect from the above date to take account of these changes.
