



AUSTRALIAN CUSTOMS DUMPING NOTICE NO. 2006/63

Tariff Classification changes to goods subject to anti-dumping measures and securities

Amendment to Australian Customs Dumping Notice 2006/60

In Australian Customs Dumping Notice (ACDN) 2006/60 of 6 December 2006, Customs advised of changes to the tariff classifications and statistical codes of certain commodities currently subject to securities, interim dumping duty and dumping duty.

Commodities affected by the changes are Dichlorophenoxy-acetic acid (2,4-D), hollow structural sections and carpet grippers. The changes to tariff classifications relating to 2,4-D as advised in that notice and to take effect from 1 January 2007 were incorrect.

The correct classifications are tabled below:
