CUSTOMS ACT 1901 - PART XVB

**WITHDRAWAL OF AN APPLICATION FOR A DUMPING DUTY
NOTICE IN RESPECT OF GUN ROVINGS EXPORTED FROM
THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA AND SPAIN**

On 13 February 1997, as a result of an application lodged by ACI Fibreglass, Customs initiated an investigation into the alleged dumping of gun rovings from the People's Republic of China and from Spain.

The goods were defined as 'E' glass rovings, designed for use with all types of 'spray-up', 'depositor' and 'chopper' guns in the fibreglass industry.

During the investigation, Customs found evidence that injury suffered by the Australian industry was not caused by dumped imports from the nominated countries. ACI Fibreglass chose to withdraw its application. Consequently, Customs will not be making a preliminary finding in this matter.
