REVIEW FINDING ON A4 COPY PAPER

**EXPORTED FROM INDONESIA
BY PT PABRIK KERTAS TJIWI KIMIA**

The Australian Customs Service has completed its review of the anti-dumping measures imposed on A4 copy paper exported from Indonesia by Tjiwi Kimia. A summary of the review report is attached.

While the review was in progress, the exporter declined to renew the price undertaking at the revised level. In view of the evidence indicating that anti-dumping measures were warranted, Customs' report recommended that the Minister publish dumping notices.

Subsequent to the completion of Customs' report, Tjiwi Kimia reviewed its position and offered to renew the price undertaking at the revised levels. The Minister has agreed to the offer and the revised price undertaking came into effect on 30 July 1997.

Bona fide importers of the goods subject to the review may obtain details of the new anti-dumping measures from the Compliance Improvement Branch at the Customs office in their respective State capital cities.
