



## AUSTRALIAN CUSTOMS DUMPING NOTICE NO.2003/07

---

*CUSTOMS ACT 1901 – PART XV B*

### **Continuous Ambulatory Peritoneal Dialysis Bag systems exported from the Federal Republic of Germany - termination of an investigation**

The Chief Executive Officer (CEO) has terminated the investigation into alleged dumping of 2 Litre and 2.5 Litre Continuous Ambulatory Peritoneal Dialysis (CAPD) bag systems exported to Australia from the Federal Republic of Germany.

Customs initiated an investigation on 8 August 2002 following an application by Baxter Healthcare Pty Ltd. A statement of the essential facts of the investigation was placed on the public file on 13 December 2002 and a copy sent to all interested parties. Responses to the statement were considered.

Customs found that any injury to the Australian industry that has, or may be, caused by the dumping of the goods is negligible. Under the circumstances, s. 269TDA(13) of the *Customs Act 1901* requires the CEO to terminate the investigation.

The applicant may request a review of my decision by lodging an application for a review with the Trade Measures Review Officer, in the approved form and manner, within 30 days of publication of this notice.

Notice of this decision will be published in *The Australian* on 12 February 2003.
